## Guest Speaker(s):

 Angie Reinking, Representative from United-went over Value Added Benefits. Rewards program will not send credit card for seeking medical services to those not targeted. United changed adult dental to allow \$500 for fillings each benefit year. No changes made to the vision coverage. They are offering a Home Helper catalog and if person supported owns their own home, pest control coverage is offered but does not include bed bug treatments. Rides to support group meeting and social activities are included-Logistic Care is who provides transportation until June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019 and as of July 1<sup>st</sup> there will be a new vendor. Will offer Medic Alert options in the event the person supported wanders away, up to 40 hours a week of respite care and an eBook members and caregivers can download. Added benefit for children's coverage is additional transportation.
