• Expectations for submitting documents to Assessors (email sent 12/2/2020)

All documents must be submitted electronically **2 days prior** to the meeting. Documents need to be **emailed** rather than dropped off in person due to Assessors working remote. **Please do not submit any additional documentation that is not required for the meeting.** 

## Documents submitted by email 2 days prior to the meeting:

- New (within the last year) medical diagnosis documentation
- New (within the last year) epileptic seizure diagnosis documentation
- **ONE** current medication log (only submit the medication log the Assessor should use. Do not submit additional medication logs)
- Diet, in writing, only if not submitted within the last 2 years.
- All behavior tracking from all providers. As a reminder, behavior tracking must be submitted for all individuals who are getting paid supports in their home.

## **Guidance from Derik Flerlage, Infection Disease Division Manager, SCHD:**

- Full PPE is face shield worn with surgical mask. Only protects the wearer.

- Agency Testing Information: Contact information (attached) on laboratories providing testing capability to our LTCF. In Shawnee County Region 3 this is 4M. The point of contact to begin discussions would be Mandy O'Rear. (mandy@4mhealthlabs.com) or 913-222-5600. Provider's can reach out directly to the labs and KDHE will pay for the cost of testing on the back end for facilities once they are set up. See attached Powerpoint: KS Unified Testing Strategy.
- Guidance on 10 day quarantine for exposed individuals and monitoring of symptoms through 14 days: See attached: CDDO Guidance 002
- Plan for staff shortages. There cannot be crossover between positives and non-positives. Asymptomatic positives can potentially still work with other positives but the situation needs to be approved by the Health Department. See attached:

#### COVID:

- Send the CDDO an updated number of staff at each agency
- Tracing Assessment: (attached) Complete for contacts 48 hours prior to symptoms/testing
- Group gathering/holidays: We encourage you to stay within your own group as much as possible
- PPE inventory: Providers need to stay on top of keeping an inventory. Looking online is the best option. Order supplies early knowing there will be shipping times.
- If a person is being tested, the CDDO needs to be notified right away. If positive the provider needs to submit tracing right away.
- If positive, complete a CIR/AIR. We want TCM's and providers to complete them.
