- To become familiar with human rights.
- To know the responsibilities associated with those rights.
- To increase self-advocacy.
- To reduce fear of reporting incidents of abuse, neglect and exploitation by learning the process and expectations.
- To increase confidence in ability to speak up.
- To experience a positive interaction with a police officer.
- To increase knowledge of potential danger in community, home and work place.
- To develop a plan for personal safety.
- To recognize an emergency and know what to do.
- To be encouraged to teach others about rights, responsibilities, advocacy and personal safety.
